Large baggage cannot be taken into the exhibition areas. Please leave it in the coin-re-turn lockers or at the informa-tion counter on the 1st floor.





Running and frolicking on or near escalator or stairs or in the exhibition areas are prohibited because it is dangerous and bothersome to other visitors.


